## Reduce Costs and Improve Quality by the use of Standard Welding Procedure Specifications.

Standard Welding Procedure Specifications (SWPS) are available from AWS for many materials and processes.

Both AWS D1.1 and ASME Boiler & Pressure Vessel Code, Section IX allows the use of these documents. The use of these documents eliminates the costly development of Procedure Qualification Reports (PQR) where the SWPSs are applicable and allowed.
