Media Registration Opens for FABTECH 2013

Chicago, IL – Online media registration is now open for journalists to attend FABTECH, North America's largest metal forming, fabricating, welding and finishing event that will be held in Chicago, November 18-21. The event is expected to attract 35,000 manufacturers – a record number - to McCormick Place to view 1,500 exhibits, including live equipment demonstrations, on more than 550,000 net square feet of floor space. exhibitors can network in a fun and casual setting and a Comedy & Cocktails event that will feature a veteran Chicago improv group.
